HOU DE SOUSA WINS DUPONT UNDERGROUND "RE-BALL!" COMPETITION



On April 30, the three-inch, translucent plastic balls from the Building Museum's Summer 2015 "Beach" exhibit as a magnetic art installation called "Raise/Raze."

The exhibit repurposes 650,000 of the balls into an assembly block system that is fully reconfigurable. And while

the installation will open with pre-assembled "zones," visitors will be free to alter the installation to create their own objects and spaces. The winning proposal was submitted by Hou de Sousa, an award-winning architecture and design studio based in New York City. In 1963, Michael Werner opened his first gallery in Berlin, with an exhibition of works by Georg Baselitz. Since then, Michael Werner Gallery—now based in Berlin, New York, and London—has



worked with a number of the most important artists of the 20th Century. Werner and his Gallery have a long-standing relationship with the Phillips,

a collaboration resulting in a generous gift of 46 works by Georg Baselitz, Jörg Immendorff, Per Kirkeby, Markus Lüpertz, and A. R. Penck. 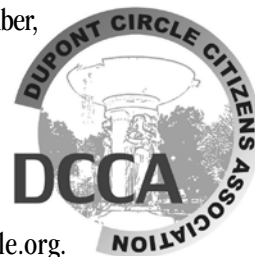

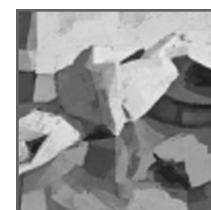
